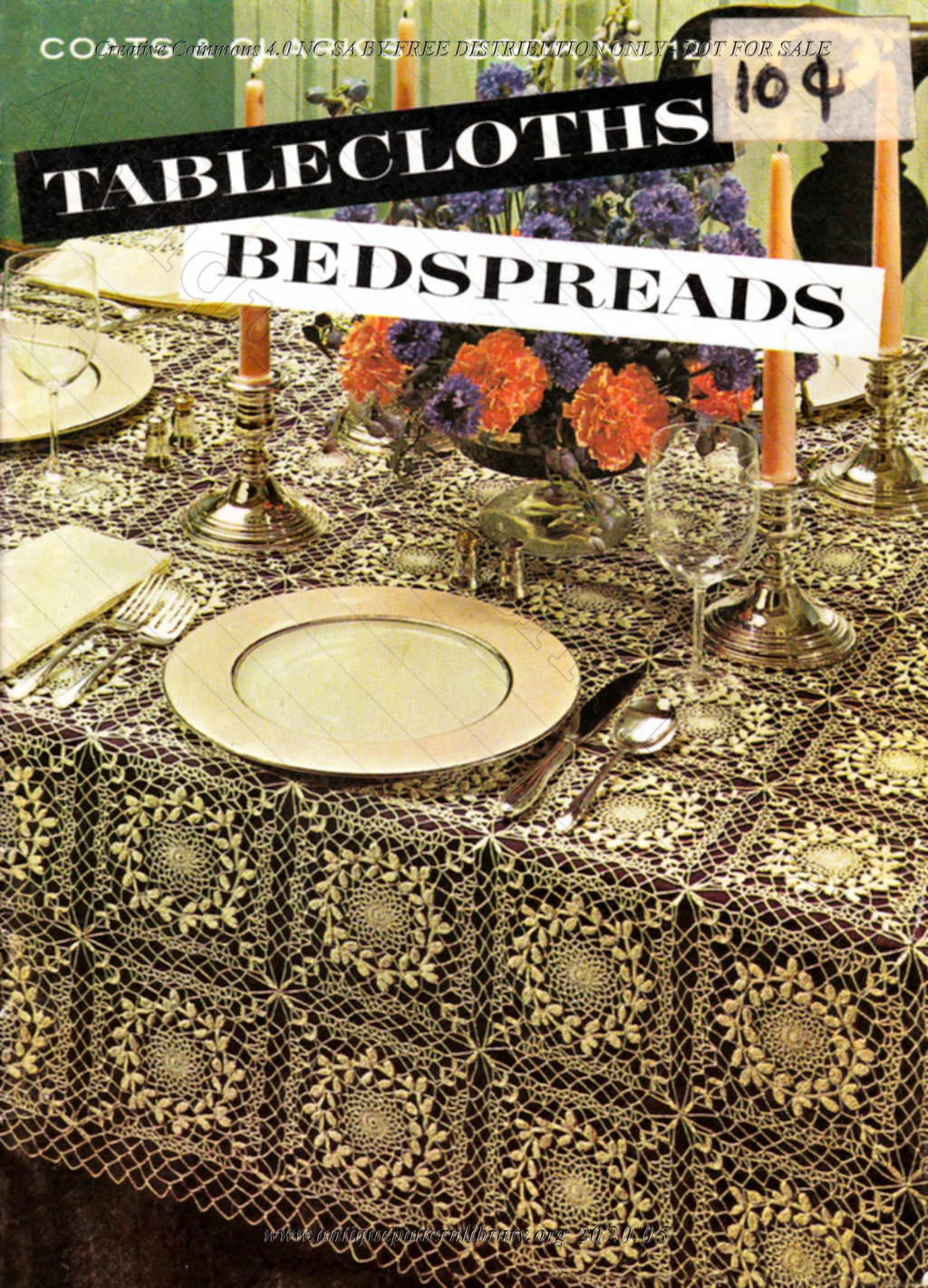

## Harvest Home Bedspread A-318

The popular wheat pattern in a new interpretation graces both traditional and modern decors

**J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A. 64:**

**For Single Size Spread (75 x 105 inches):**  
41 balls of No. 51 Spice and 58 balls of No. 61 Ecu; or

**For Double Size Spread (90 x 105 inches):**  
49 balls of Spice and 70 balls of Ecu.

**Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.**

**Motif measures 7½ inches square.**

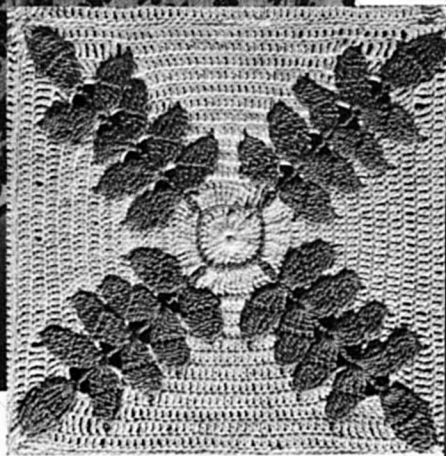
**MOTIF** . . . Starting at center with Ecu, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st Ecu Rnd:** Ch 5, 27 d tr in ring. Join to top of ch-5 (28 d tr, counting ch-5 as 1 d tr). Drop Ecu and slip loop from hook onto a holder or safety pin. **1st Spice Rnd:** Attach Spice in joining, sl st in 28 d tr; draw loop on hook up to measure about 6 inches, draw Spice ball through loop then pull thread tight to fasten off the loop. *Do not break off.* **1st Mixed Color Rnd:** Slip Ecu loop onto hook, **working over the thread not in use throughout (in order to conceal it)**, ch 5, Ecu d tr in joining, 2 Ecu d tr in back loop of next 2 d tr on first Ecu Rnd; \* make an Ecu d tr in back loop of next Ecu d tr to the point where 2 loops remain on hook, drop Ecu, with Spice complete the st; make a Spice tr tr in same d tr to point where 2 loops remain on hook, drop Spice, with Ecu complete the st; 2 Ecu d tr in back loop of next 6 Ecu d tr. Repeat from \* around until the 4th Spice tr tr has been made; leaving Spice strand free at back

of work, make 2 Ecu d tr in back loop of last 3 Ecu d tr. Join to top of ch-5, drop Ecu and slip loop on holder.

**NOTE:** Hereafter, always keep loop on holder and strand not in use to FRONT of work and out of the way until the directions call for the use of the color on holder, then slip loop from holder to hook.

**2nd Spice Rnd:** Draw up a Spice loop in last Spice tr tr made; make a starting Wheat Stalk as follows: Ch 5, in tr tr make 4 d tr for first half leaf, ch 3, d tr for stem, ch 3, and 5 d tr for second half leaf; (ch 5, make a Wheat Stalk in next Spice tr tr as follows: 5 d tr for first half leaf, ch 3, d tr for stem, ch 3 and 5 d tr for second half leaf) 3 times; ch 5. Join, drop Spice and slip loop onto holder. **2nd Ecu Rnd:** Ch 3, skip joining, working over the Spice ch-5, dc in next 2 Ecu d tr; \* holding Wheat Stalk to front of work and out of the way, 2 dc in next 3 Ecu d tr; ch 3, skip next 2 Ecu d tr, 2 dc in next 3 Ecu d tr; working over Spice ch-5, dc in next 5 Ecu d tr. Repeat from \* around, ending with dc in last 2 Ecu d tr. Join to top of ch-3, (17 dc on each side, counting ch-3 as 1 dc). **3rd Ecu Rnd:** Ch 3, skip joining, \* dc in each dc across side to within Ecu sp, 3 sc in Spice sp, ch 3, 3 sc in next Spice sp. Repeat from \* around. Join as before. **4th Ecu Rnd:** Ch 3, skip joining, \* dc in each Ecu st across side to within Ecu sp, ch 5.

**J. & P. COATS "BIG BALL" BEST SIX CORD  
MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. A. 104, Size  
30: 27 balls of No. 1 White, No. 61  
Ecru or No. 42 Cream for Small  
Cloth; 37 balls for Large Cloth; or**

**CLARK'S "BIG BALL" MERCERIZED CROCHET,  
Art. B. 34, Size 30: 20 balls of No. 1  
White, No. 61 Ecru or No. 42 Cream  
for Small Cloth; 26 balls for Large  
Cloth; or**

**CLARK'S "BIG BALL" MERCERIZED CROCHET,  
Art. B. 345, Size 30: 12 balls of White  
or Ecru only for Small Cloth; 16  
balls for Large Cloth.**

**Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.**

**Small Cloth measures 60½ inches square;  
Large Cloth measures 60½ x 81½ inches.**

**Each Motif measures 5¼ inches square and  
requires 53½ yards.**

**FIRST MOTIF . . .** Starting at center, ch 4.  
**1st rnd:** Make 15 dc in 4th ch from  
hook. Join with sl st to top of starting  
chain (16 dc, counting starting chain as  
1 dc). **2nd rnd:** Ch 6, dc in joining; in  
each dc around make dc, ch 3 and dc.  
Join to 3rd ch of ch-6 (16 sps). **Next  
2 rnds:** Sl st in next ch, in next ch make  
sl st, ch 6 and dc; in center ch of each  
of the next 15 sps make dc, ch 3 and  
dc. Join as on 2nd rnd. **5th rnd:** Sl st in  
next ch, in sp make sl st, ch 1 and sc;  
(ch 7, sc in next sp) 15 times; ch 4,  
dc in first sc to form last loop (16 loops).  
**6th rnd:** Sc in loop just formed, (ch 9,  
make 6 d tr in 5th ch from hook, drop  
loop off hook, insert hook in top of  
chain and draw dropped loop through—  
pc st made; sc in next loop) 15 times;  
ch 9, make a pc st. Join to first sc (16  
pc sts).

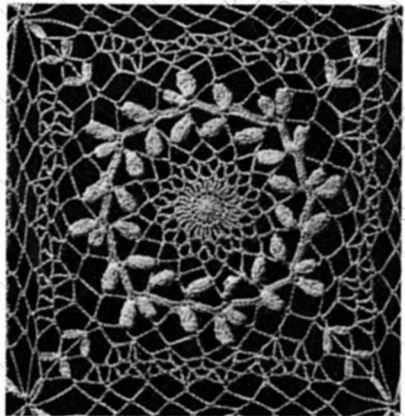
**7th rnd:** Sl st in next 4 ch, ch 1, (sc at base of pc st, ch 8) 16 times. Join as before. **8th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining, (9 sc in next loop, sc in next sc) 15 times; 9 sc in last loop. Join. **9th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining, \* ch 5, 6 d tr in last sc made, complete a pc st as before; ch 5, skip next 7 sc, sc in next 3 sc; ch 4, 5 tr in last sc made, complete a pc st as before; ch 4, skip next 7 sc, sc in next 3 sc. Repeat from \* around, ending with sc in last 2 sc. Join. **10th rnd:** Sl st to top of pc st, ch 1, (sc in next loop, ch 9, skip next sc, 7 d tr in next sc, complete pc st as before, ch 7, sc in next loop, ch 9) 7 times; sc in next loop, ch 9, skip next sc, 7-d tr pc st in next sc, ch 4, d tr in first sc to form last loop (8 pc sts and 24 loops). **11th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in loop, \* ch 9, in next loop make sc, ch 7 and sc; ch 9, sc in next loop, (ch 7, sc in next loop) 4 times. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 3, tr in first sc to form last loop. **12th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in loop, ch 3; in same sc as last tr on 11th rnd was made, make tr, ch 2 and tr (V st made); \* V st in center ch of next loop, ch 4; holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make 3 tr in center ch of next loop, thread over and draw through all 4 loops on hook (cluster made); ch 4, in same center chain make d tr, ch 4 and 3-tr cluster (corner made); ch 4, V st in center ch of next loop, V st in next sc, (ch 3, sc in next loop, ch 3, dc in next sc) 3 times; ch 3, sc in next loop, ch 3, V st in next sc. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 3. Join to first sc.

**13th rnd:** Ch 3, \* skip next sp, in first ch of next V st make dc, ch 2 and dc (Dc-V st over V st made); Tr-V st in first ch of next V st (Tr-V st over V st made); Tr-V st in 2nd ch of next sp, ch 3, in corner d tr make 3-tr cluster, ch 4, d tr, ch 4 and 3-tr cluster; ch 3, skip next cluster, Tr-V st in 3rd ch of next sp, Tr-V st over V st, Dc-V st over

V st, skip next sp, Dc-V st in center ch of next 4 sps, Dc-V st in next sc. Repeat from \* around, ending with Dc-V st in center ch of next 4 sps; dc in joining of 12th rnd (at base of first ch-3), ch 3, sl st in top of first ch-3 to complete first V st. **14th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining, ch 9, skip next 2 V-st sps, sc in first tr of next V st, ch 9, skip V-st sp, sc in next sp, ch 11, holding back loops as for tr cluster, make 3 d tr in corner d tr, complete cluster as for tr cluster, \* ch 11, skip next cluster, sc in next sp, ch 9, skip next V-st sp, sc in first tr of next V st, (ch 9, skip next 2 V-st sps, sc in first st of next V st) 5 times; ch 9, skip V-st sp, sc in next sp, ch 11, 3-d tr cluster in corner d tr. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 9. Join, break off and fasten.

**SECOND MOTIF . . .** Work exactly as for First Motif until first corner cluster on 14th rnd has been completed. Now work as follows: Sl st in any corner cluster on First Motif, ch 11; on Second Motif, skip next cluster, sc in next sp, ch 4; on First Motif, skip next ch-11 loop, sc in next ch-9 loop, ch 4; on Second Motif, skip next V-st sp, sc in first tr of next V st; (ch 4, sl st in next

**J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A. 64:**

**For Single Size (73 x 109 inches):** 36 balls of No. 42 Cream, 38 balls of No. 51 Spice and 7 balls of No. 131 Fudge Brown.

**For Double Size (91 x 109 inches):** 45 balls of No. 42 Cream, 47 balls of No. 51 Spice and 8 balls of No. 131 Fudge Brown.

**Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.**

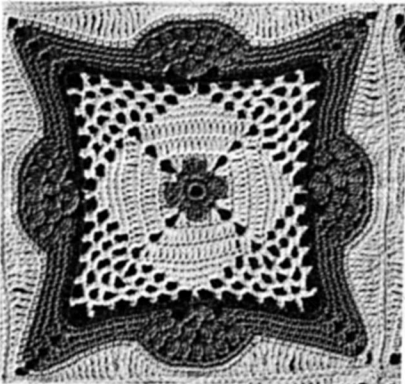
**Motif measures 6 inches square.**

**MOTIF . . .** Starting at center with Spice, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 1, 12 sc in ring. Join to first sc. **2nd rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining, (in next sc make 2 dc, tr and 2 dc, sc in next

2 sc) 3 times; in next sc make 2 dc, tr and 2 dc; sc in next sc. Join as before. Break off and fasten. **3rd rnd:** Attach Cream to joining, ch 3, dc in joining, \* skip next dc, **picking up back loop only**, sc in next 3 sts, skip next dc, **working through both loops**, 2 dc in next sc, ch 3, 2 dc in next sc (corner). Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 3. Join to top of ch-3. **4th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in joining, \* dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in next dc, in next corner sp make 2 dc, ch 3 and 2 dc (open shell made); 2 dc in next dc. Repeat from \* around, ending with an open shell. Join as before. **5th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in next 10 dc, \* in next corner sp make dc, tr, ch 3, tr and dc (large corner shell); dc in next 13 dc. Repeat from \* around, ending with dc in last 2 dc. Join.

**6th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining and in next 10 dc, \* ch 3, skip next dc, h dc in next tr, ch 3, in next corner sp make dc, ch 3 and dc (corner V st made); ch 3, h dc in next tr, ch 3, skip next dc, sc in next 13 dc. Repeat from \* around, ending with sc in last 2 dc. Join as on first rnd. **7th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining and in next 8 sc, \* (ch 3, sc in next loop) twice; ch 3, V st in next corner sp, (ch 3, sc in next loop) twice; ch 3, skip next 2 sc, sc in next 9 sc. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 1, h dc in first sc to form last loop.

**8th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in loop just formed, ch 3, skip next sc, \* sc in next 5 sc, (ch 3, sc in next loop) 3 times; ch 3, V st in next corner sp, (ch 3, sc in next loop) 3 times; ch 3, skip next 2 sc. Repeat from \* around, ending as for 7th rnd. **9th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in loop just formed, ch 3, sc in next loop, \* ch 3, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc, (ch 3, sc in next loop) 4 times; ch 3, in next corner sp make dc, ch 5 and dc; (ch 3, sc in next loop) 4 times. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 3. Join to first sc. Break off and fasten. **10th rnd:** Attach Brown to any corner sp, (7 sc in corner sp, 3 sc in each of next 5 loops, sc in next sc, 3 sc in each of next 5 loops) 4 times. Join as before. Break off and fasten. **11th rnd:** Attach Spice to center sc of any corner group, \* working through both loops, in corner sc make sc, ch 3 and sc; **picking up back loops only**, sc in next 15 sc; ch 2, skip next 3 sc; *working through both loops*, in next sc make (cluster, ch 2) 3 times—**to make a cluster, holding back on hook last loop of each st, make 3 dc in designated place, thread over and draw through all loops on hook**; skip next 3 sc; **picking up back loops only**, sc in next 15 sc. Repeat from \* around. Join.

**12th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining, \* open shell (as on 4th rnd) in next corner sp; sc in next 12 sc, skip next sc, sc in next sc, cluster in next sp, ch 2, cluster in tip of next cluster, (ch 2, cluster in next sp) twice; ch 2, cluster in tip of next cluster, ch 2, cluster in next sp, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc, skip next sc, sc in next 12 sc. Repeat from \* around, ending with sc in last 11 sc. Join. **13th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining and in next 2 dc; \* open shell in next corner sp, sc in next 10 sts, skip next sc, sc in next 4 sc, cluster in tip of next cluster, (ch 2, cluster in next sp) twice; ch 2, (cluster in tip of next cluster,

ch 2, cluster in next sp, ch 2) twice; cluster in next sp, ch 2, cluster in tip of next cluster; sc in next 4 sc, skip next sc, sc in next 10 sts. Repeat from \* around, ending with sc in last 7 sc. Join. **14th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining and in next 4 sts, \* open shell in next corner sp, sc in next 10 sts, skip next sc, sc in next 3 sc, sc in tip of next cluster, sc in next sp, (sc in tip of next cluster, 2 sc in next sp) 6 times; sc in tip of next cluster, sc in next sp, sc in tip of next cluster, skip next 2 sc, sc in next 3 sc, skip next sc, sc in next 10 sts. Repeat from \* around, ending with sc in last 5 sc. Join. Break off and fasten.

**15th rnd:** Attach Cream to any corner sp, (in corner sp make sc, ch 5 and sc; sc in next 14 sts. *Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc, thread over and draw through all loops on hook—1 sc decreased*; sc in next 21 sc, dec 1 sc over next 2 sc, sc in next 14 sc) 4 times. Join. **16th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining, \* in next corner sp make 2 sc, ch 1 and 2 sc; sc in next 2 sc, h dc in next 3 sc, dc in next 3 sc, tr in next 2 sc, d tr in next 2 sc, (making d tr's instead of dc's, make a 2-d tr cluster over next 2 sc) twice; tr in next sc; working as before, make a cluster consisting of a tr and dc over next 2 sc; dc in next sc, h dc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, dec 2 sc over next 3 sc, sc in next 4 sc, h dc in next sc, dc in next sc, make a cluster consisting of a dc and tr over next 2 sc, tr in next sc, (2-d tr cluster over next 2 sc) twice; d tr in next 2 sc, tr in next 2 sc, dc in next 3 sc, h dc in next 3 sc, sc in next 2 sc. Repeat from \* around. Join, break off and fasten.

Make and neatly sew together 12 x 18 motifs for Single Size Spread or 15 x 18 motifs for Double Size Spread.

**BORDER . . .** Attach thread to any st. **1st rnd:** Ch 1, keeping work flat, sc closely around, making 3 sc in each corner. Join. Repeat first rnd for ½ inch. Break off and fasten.

Repeat from \* around. Join, drop Ecru and slip loop onto holder (23 dc on each side, counting as before).

**3rd Spice Rnd:** Work across first Wheat Stalk as follows: Ch 5, holding back on hook the last loop of each d tr, d tr in next 4 d tr, thread over and draw through all loops on hook, ch 1 very tightly to fasten (**cluster made and first leaf completed**); ch 4, holding Ecru loops to **back** of work and out of the way, make a Wheat Stalk (as on 2nd Spice rnd) in the stem d tr; ch 4, make a 5-d tr cluster over the 5 d tr of second half leaf to complete second leaf; (ch 5, **across next Wheat Stalk make 5-d tr cluster over first half leaf to complete the leaf, ch 4; holding Ecru loops out of way as before, make a Wheat Stalk in stem d tr; ch 4, 5-d tr cluster over second half leaf to complete the leaf**) 3 times; ch 5, sl st in tip of first leaf, the next 4 ch and the first d tr of next half leaf. Drop Spice and slip loop onto holder.

**5th Ecru Rnd:** Ch 3, skip joining, dc in next dc, \* *inserting hook through tip of next leaf and then in the dc, dc in next dc (leaf fastened)*; holding ch-4 between leaf and half leaf to **back** of work and out of the way, dc in next 4 dc; holding Wheat Stalk to **front** of work and out of the way, dc in next 5 dc, 3 sc in next **Spice** sp, ch 3, 3 sc in next **Spice** sp, dc in next 5 dc; holding ch-4 between half leaf and leaf to **back** of work as before, dc in next 4 dc; fastening leaf as before, dc in next dc; holding ch-5 between Wheat Stalks to **back** of work and out of the way, dc in next 3 dc. Repeat from \* around, ending with dc in dc fastening leaf, dc in last dc. Join.

**6th Ecru Rnd:** Repeat 4th Ecru Rnd (29 dc on each side).

**4th Spice Rnd:** Work as for 3rd Spice Rnd, making ch 15 (instead of ch-5) between Wheat Stalks. **NOTE:** Hereafter,

when working the first Ecru rnd following a Spice rnd, be sure you **DO NOT** work over the Spice chains but keep them free along back of motif except where the directions specifically state to work over the chains.

**7th Ecru Rnd:** Ch 3, skip joining; holding ch-15 between Wheat Stalks to **back** of work as before, dc in next 2 dc; \* working over ch-15, dc in next dc; holding ch-15 to **back** of work and out of way, dc in next 3 dc; dc in next dc fastening leaf; holding chain between leaf and half leaf to **back** as before, dc in next 4 dc; holding Wheat Stalk to **front** as before, dc in last 3 dc of side, 3 sc in next **Spice** sp, ch 3, 3 sc in next **Spice** sp, dc in first 3 dc of side; holding chain between half leaf and leaf to **back** as before, dc in next 4 dc; dc in next dc fastening leaf; holding ch-15 to **back** as before, dc in next 3 dc; working over ch-15, dc in next dc; holding ch-15 to **back** as before; dc in next 5 dc. Repeat from \* around. Join.

**8th Ecru Rnd:** Repeat 4th Ecru Rnd (35 dc on each side).

**5th Spice Rnd:** Work as for 3rd Spice Rnd, making ch-21 instead of ch-5 between Wheat Stalks.

**9th Ecru Rnd:** Ch 3, skip joining, holding ch-21 to **back** as before, dc in next 4 dc; working over ch-21, dc in next dc; \* holding ch-21 to **back** as before, dc in next 4 dc; dc in next dc fastening leaf; holding chain between leaf and half leaf to **back** as before, dc in next 4 dc; holding Wheat Stalk to **front** as before, dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in last dc on side, 3 sc in next **Spice** sp, ch 3, 3 sc in next **Spice** sp, 2 dc in first dc on next side, dc in next 2 dc; holding chain between half leaf and leaf to **back** as before, dc in next 4 dc; dc in next dc fastening leaf; (holding ch-21 to **back** as before, dc in next 4 dc; working over ch-21, dc in next dc) 3 times. Repeat from \* around, ending with dc in next 3 dc holding ch-21 to **back**; working over ch-21, dc in last dc. Join.

No. 61 Ecru or Any

**Small Cloth:** No. 42 Cream Color  
Art. A. 104 ..... 25 balls.....31 balls  
Art. B. 34 ..... 18 balls.....25 balls  
Art. B. 345 ..... 11 balls of White or  
Ecru only

**Large Cloth:**  
Art. A. 104 ..... 33 balls.....41 balls  
Art. B. 34 ..... 24 balls.....33 balls  
Art. B. 345 ..... 14 balls of White or  
Ecru only

**Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.**

**Small Cloth measures 63 inches square;  
Large Cloth measures 63 x 83 inches.**

**Each Motif measures 5 inches square and  
requires 40½ yards of thread.**

**FIRST MOTIF** . . . Starting at center, ch 7.  
Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:**  
Ch 3, 23 dc in ring. Join to top of  
ch-3 (24 dc, counting ch-3 as 1 dc). **2nd  
rnd:** Ch 3, skip joining, 2 dc in next dc  
(1 dc increased), dc in next dc (leaf  
started); (ch 2, dc in next dc, 2 dc in  
next dc, dc in next dc—another leaf  
started) 7 times; ch 2. Join as before  
(8 leaves). **3rd rnd:** Ch 3, dc in joining  
(1 dc increased at beg of first leaf), dc  
in next 2 dc, 2 dc in last dc of leaf,  
ch 2, (2 dc in first dc of leaf, dc in next  
2 dc, 2 dc in last dc of leaf) 7 times; ch 2.

Join. **Next 3 rnds:** Ch 3, (increasing 1 dc  
at both ends, dc in each dc of leaf, ch 2)  
8 times. Join (12 dc in each leaf on 6th  
rnd). **7th rnd:** Ch 3, skip joining, \* dc in  
each dc of leaf to within last 2 dc, hold-  
ing back on hook the last loop of each  
dc, dc in last 2 dc, thread over and  
draw through all 3 loops on hook (1 dc  
decreased); ch 3, in next sp make dc,  
ch 5 and dc (corner made); ch 3, decreas-  
ing 1 dc at both ends of leaf, dc in each  
dc across leaf; ch 3, dec 1 dc over first  
2 dc of next leaf. Repeat from \* around,  
ending with ch 3, skip first ch-3, sl st  
in next dc to decrease first st of first  
leaf (1 dc decreased at both ends of  
each leaf).

**8th rnd:** Ch 3, skip joining, \* work  
across leaf as for 7th rnd, ch 3, dc in  
next dc, ch 3, in corner loop make dc,  
ch 5 and dc; ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 3,  
work across leaf as for 7th rnd, ch 5,  
sc in next loop, ch 5. Repeat from \*  
around, ending with dec first st of first  
leaf as on 7th rnd. **9th rnd:** Ch 3, skip  
joining, \* work across leaf as for 7th  
rnd; ch 3, (dc in next dc, ch 3) twice;  
holding back last loops as for a dec,  
make 3 tr in corner loop, thread over  
and draw through all 4 loops on hook  
(cluster made), ch 5, 3-tr cluster in same  
corner loop, ch 3, (dc in next dc, ch 3)  
twice; work across leaf as for 7th rnd;  
ch 5, (sc in next loop, ch 5) twice.  
Repeat from \* around, completing first  
leaf as on 7th rnd (6 sts remain in each  
leaf). **10th rnd:** Ch 3, skip joining, \* work  
across leaf as for 7th rnd, ch 3, (dc in

## Tropic Seas Knitted Bedspread A-322

**For Single Size (65 x 105 inches):** 39 balls of No. 1 White, No. 61 Ecu or No. 42 Cream, or 55 balls of any color.

**For Double Size (88 x 105 inches):** 54 balls of No. 1 White, No. 61 Ecu or No. 42 Cream, or 76 balls of any color.

Knitting needles, 1 pair No. 1.

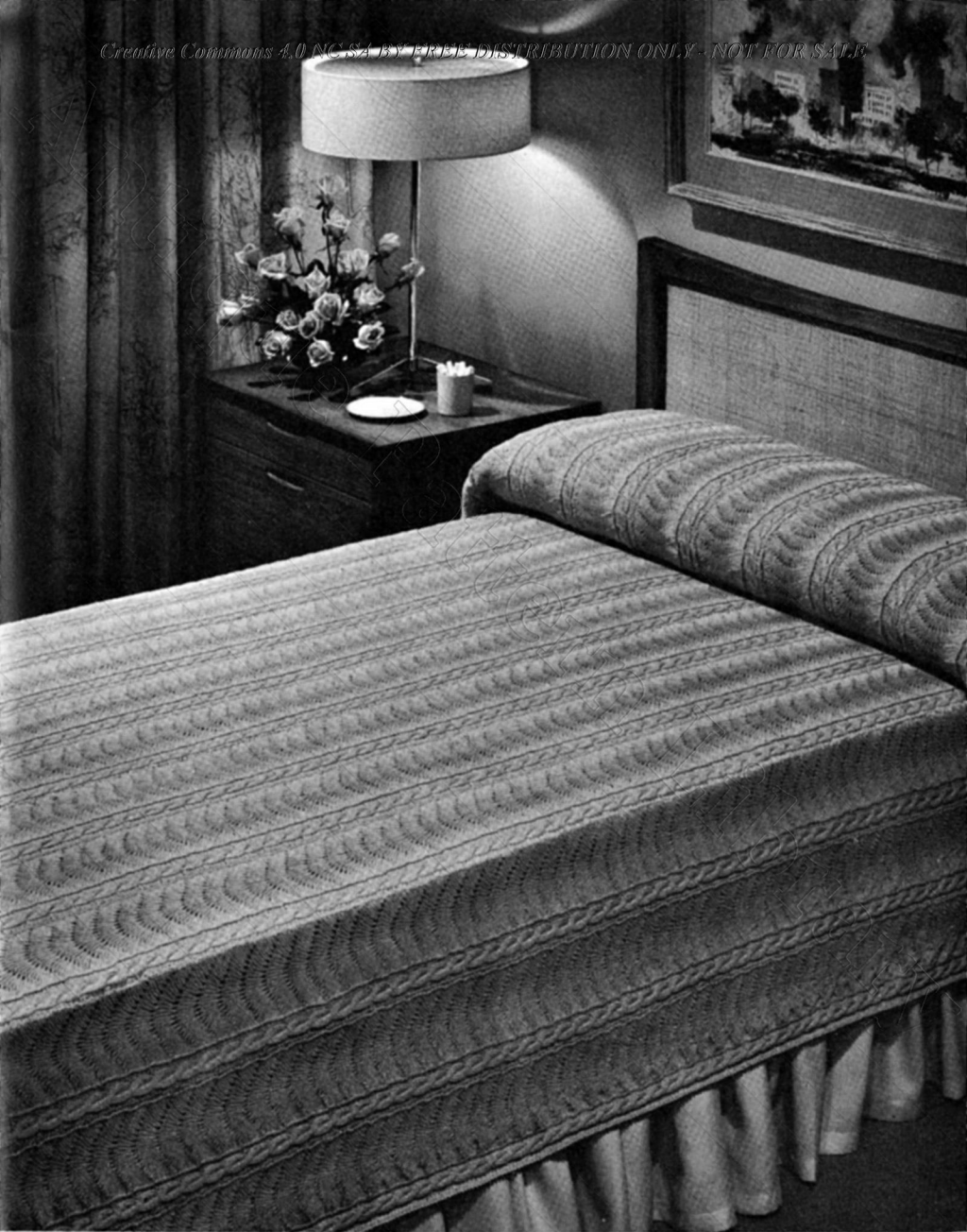
**GAUGE:** 115 sts = 14¼ inches; 10 rows = 1 inch.

**MAIN STRIP (Make 4 for Single Size or 5 for Double Size) . . .** Cast on 115 sts. **1st row (wrong side):** K 2 for edge; (k 3, p 8, k 3 for cable panel, slip a marker on needle; drop working thread, slip next 11 sts from left-hand needle to right-hand needle as if to purl, attach another strand of thread in next st on left-hand needle, now work short rows as follows: p 4, turn; sl 1, k 6, turn; sl 1, p 9, turn; sl 1, k 12, turn; sl 1, p 15, turn; sl 1, k 18, turn; sl 1, p 20, turn; sl 1, k 22; fasten off strand in use; pick up working strand and p 23 for fan panel, slip a marker on needle) 3 times; k last 2 sts for edge.

**NOTE:** Hereafter, slip each of the 6 markers when working across each row. **2nd row:** K 2 edge sts, \* sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o.; (O, k 1) 19 times; O, k 2 tog (41 sts in fan panel, counting each O as 1 st); p 3, k 8, p 3. Repeat from \* twice more; k 2 edge sts. **3rd row:** Sl 2 edge sts as if to knit, (k 3, p 8, k 3; p 2 tog, p across to within 2 sts of next marker, p 2 tog) 3 times; sl 2 edge sts as if to purl.

**4th row:** K 2 edge sts, (sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o.; k across to within 2 sts of next marker, k 2 tog; p 3, k 8, p 3) 3 times; k 2 edge sts. **Next 7 rows:** Repeat 3rd and 4th rows alternately (23 sts remain in each fan panel at end of 11th row). **12th row:** K 2 edge sts, \* sl 1, k 1, p.s.s.o.; (O, k 1) 19 times; O, k 2 tog—41 sts in fan panel; p 3, slip next 4 sts onto a cable holder (or spare double-pointed needle) and hold in front of work, k next 4 sts then k the 4 sts from cable holder (cable twist made); p 3. Repeat from \* twice more; k 2 edge sts. Repeat 3rd to 12th rows incl for pattern. Work in pattern until total length is about 104 inches when measured through center of cable panels, ending with 12th pattern row.

**Upper Edge Shaping—1st row (wrong side):** Sl 2 edge sts, k 3, p 8, k 3, p 2 tog, p 19, turn; working over this set of sts only, and being sure to keep in pattern as established, (continue to dec at side of fan panel), bind off 4 sts at beg of next 3 right side rows, then bind off remaining sts at beg of next right side row; (with wrong side facing, attach thread to first bound-off st at center of fan panel on completed section; p 18, p 2 tog, k 3, p 8, k 3, p 2 tog, p 19, turn; working over this set of sts only and keeping in pattern as before, continue to dec at marker edge of both fan panels, bind off 4 sts at beg of next 6 rows, then bind off remaining sts) twice; with wrong side facing, attach thread to first bound-off st as before, Continued on page 30

**CLARK'S "BIG BALL" MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B. 345, Size 20:** 9 balls of White or Ecu only.

**Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 9.**

**Cloth measures 64 inches in diameter.**

Starting at center, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Make 12 sc in ring. Join to first sc. **2nd rnd:** Ch 4, tr in next sc (ch 7, tr in next 2 sc) 5 times; ch 3, tr in top of ch-4 to form last loop. **3rd rnd:** Ch 1, sc in loop just formed, 3 tr in same place as last tr of 2nd rnd was made, (ch 3, 3 tr in next tr, sc in next loop, 3 tr in next tr) 5 times; ch 3, 3 tr in next tr. Join to first sc. **4th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining and in each st around. Join as on 3rd rnd (60 sc). **5th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining, (ch 7, skip next 4 sc, sc in next sc) 11 times; ch 5, h dc in first sc to form last loop (12 loops). **6th rnd:** Sc in loop just formed, \* ch 5, in next loop make (sc, ch 3) twice and sc. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 5, in first loop used at beg of rnd make sc, ch 3 and sc; ch 1, h dc in first sc to form last loop (36 loops). **Next 2 rnds:** Sc in loop just formed, \* ch 3, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* around, forming last loop as on 6th rnd.

**Next 2 rnds:** Sc in loop, \* ch 4, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 2, h dc in first sc. **11th and 12th rnds:** Sc in loop, \* ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 2, dc in first sc to form last loop. **13th and 14th rnds:** Sc in loop, \* ch 6, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 3, dc in first sc to form last loop. **15th rnd:** In loop just formed make sc, ch 3 and sc (picot made), \* ch 7, picot in next loop. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 3, tr in first sc to form last loop. **16th and following 4 rnds:** Work as for 15th rnd, skipping the picots. **21st rnd:** Make a picot in loop just formed, \* ch 7, in next ch-7 loop make 3 dc, ch 3 and 3 dc (open shell made), ch 7, picot in next ch-7 loop. Repeat from \* around, forming last loop as before. **22nd rnd:** Make a picot in loop just formed, ch 7, picot in next ch-7 loop, \* ch 7, picot in next shell sp, (ch 7, picot in next ch-7 loop) twice. Repeat from \* around, forming last loop as before. **Next 6 rnds:** Repeat 16th rnd.

**NOTE:** Hereafter, always repeat from \* around to complete each rnd and form the last loop on each rnd that contains ch-5 loops as on 11th rnd, unless otherwise stated.

**29th rnd:** Sc in loop, (ch 5, sc in next picot, ch 5, sc in next loop) twice; \* tr in next sc, 3 tr in next picot (first set of leaves started), ch 5, sc in next loop, (ch 5, sc in next picot, ch 5, sc in next loop) 5 times—9 leaves started. **30th rnd:**

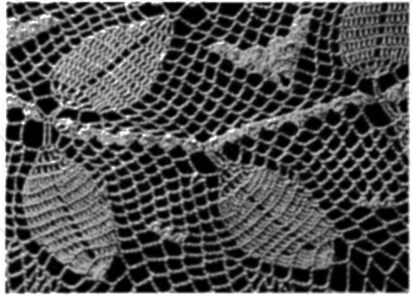

**35th rnd:** Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, (ch 5, sc in next loop) twice; \* **work across leaf as follows:** skip sc, dc in first 7 dc, ch 1, dc in last 8 dc (no increases made); (ch 5, sc in next loop) 5 times; ch 5, sc in center of next shell, (shell in next sc, sc in center of next shell) twice; (ch 5, sc in next loop) 3 times. **36th rnd:** Sc in loop, (ch 5, sc in next loop) twice; \* work across leaf as on 35th rnd; (ch 5, sc in next loop) 6 times; ch 5, sc in center of next shell, in next sc make 3 dc, ch 5 and 3 dc; sc in center of shell, (ch 5, sc in next loop) 3 times. **37th rnd:** Sc in loop, (ch 5,

End as on 33rd rnd.

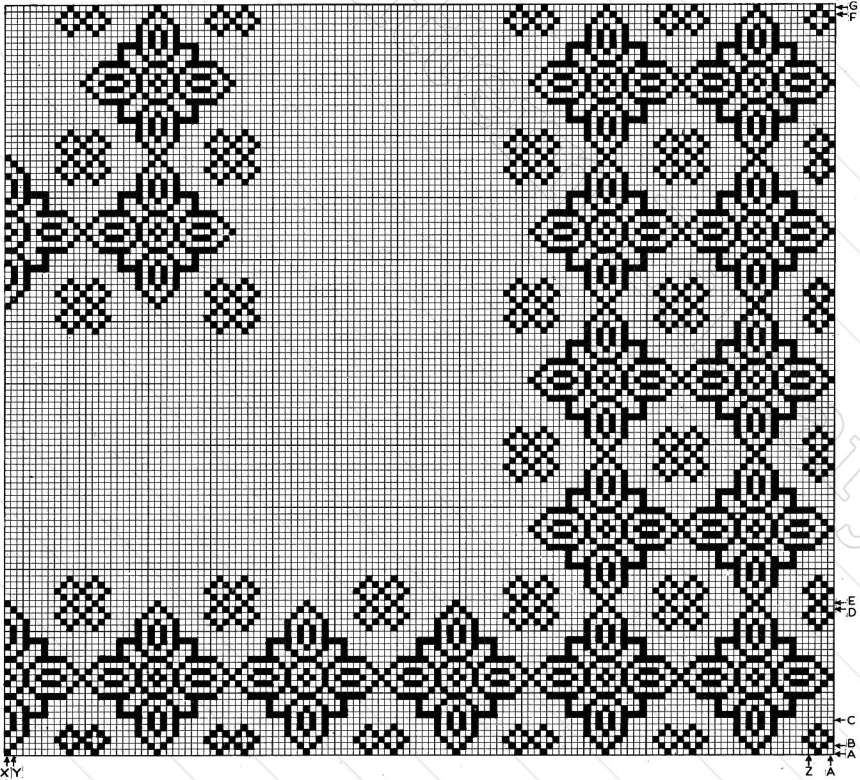

**MOTIF . . . Ring—First Flower:** With Pink, ch 8. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 1, (sc in ring, ch 3, *holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make 2 tr in ring, thread over and draw through all 3 loops on hook—cluster made;* ch 3) 6 times. Join to first sc—6 petals. Break off and fasten. **Second Flower:** Work as for First Flower until cluster of sixth petal has been completed; sl st in tip of sixth petal on First Flower, ch 3. Join, break off and fasten. **Next 3 Flowers:** Work as for Second Flower, joining 6th petal to 4th petal of previous Flower as Second Flower

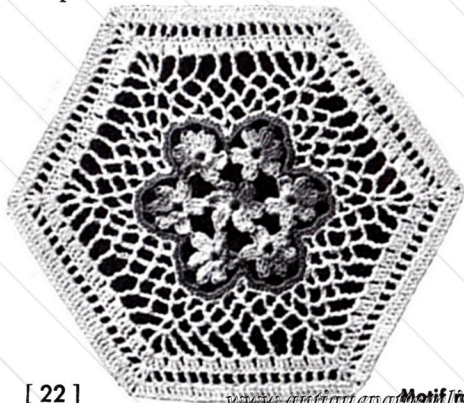

Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 2, dc in first sc to form last loop.

**5th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in loop just formed, \* ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* around, forming last loop as on 4th rnd.

**6th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in loop just formed,

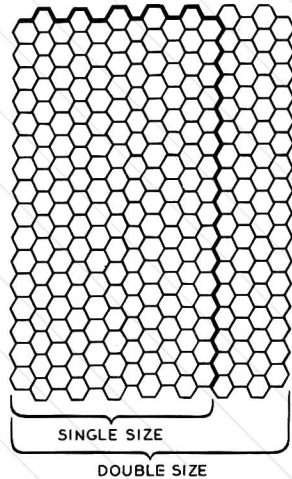

Repeat from \* across to within next corner loop. Repeat from \*\* around, ending with ch 3, tr in first sc to form last loop. **2nd rnd:** Sc in loop just formed, ch 7, in corner loop make dc, ch 5 and dc; \* ch 7, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* around, making dc, ch 5 and dc in each of the 3 remaining corner loops and end as on first rnd. **Next 3 rnds:** Sc in loop, \* ch 7, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* around, making dc, ch 5 and dc in each of the 4 corner ch-5 loops and end as on first rnd. Break off and fasten at end of last rnd. Starch lightly and press.

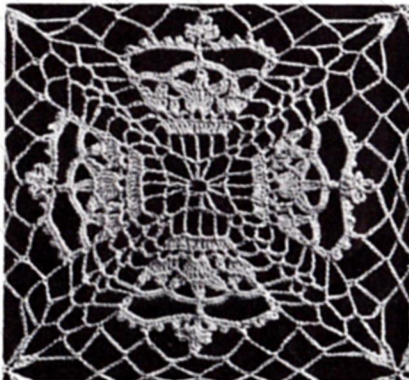

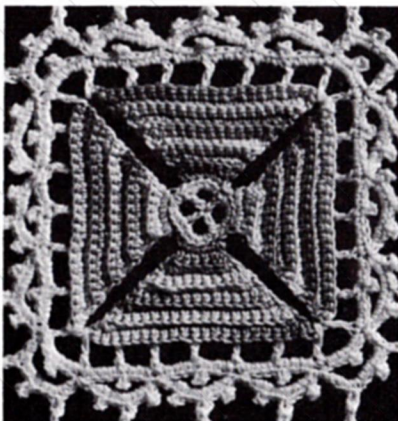

Motif measures 4½ inches square.

**FIRST MOTIF . . .** Starting at center with Blue, ch 7. **1st rnd:** In 7th ch from hook make (h dc, ch 4) 3 times. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch-7. **2nd rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining, (5 sc in next sp, sc in next h dc) 3 times; 5 sc in next sp. Join to first sc.

**NOTE:** Hereafter, pick up the **BACK loop only** of each sc until otherwise stated.



**First Cross Section—1st row (right side):** Ch 1, sc in each of the 5 sc over next sp. Ch 1, turn. **Next 8 rows:** Increasing 1 sc at both ends, sc in each sc across—to inc 1 sc, make 2 sc in 1 sc. Ch 2, turn. Break off and fasten at end of 9th rnd (21 sc).

**Next Three Cross Sections—1st row:** With right side of 2nd rnd facing, skip next sc over h dc, attach Blue to first sc of the 5 sc over next sp, ch 1 and sc in each of the 5 sc over sp. Ch 1, turn and complete section as for First Cross Section. **Do not break off at end of last section.** Ch 2, turn.

Now, complete Motif in rnds as follows: **1st rnd (wrong side):** (Make 2 sc in first sc of Cross Section, sc in next 19 sc, 2 sc in last sc of Cross Section, ch 1) 4 times. Join to first sc. Break off and fasten. Turn, attach White in last ch-1 sp made. **2nd rnd (right side):** Ch 8, dc in last ch-1 sp made (corner); \* (ch 3, skip next 3 sc, dc in next sc) 5 times; ch 3, in next ch-1 sp make dc, ch 5 and dc (another corner). Repeat from \* around, ending with ch-3, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-8 to form last loop.

**NOTE:** Hereafter, work through **both loops of sts throughout.** **3rd rnd:** Ch 1, sc in joining, \* in corner loop make 3 sc, ch 3, sl st in last sc made (picot made) and 3 sc; (sc in next dc, 3 sc in next sp, sc in next dc, picot, 3 sc in next sp) 3 times; sc in next dc. Repeat from \* around, ending with 3 sc in last sp. Join to first sc. **4th rnd:** \* Ch 9, skip next picot and following 3 sc, sl st in next

**SECOND MOTIF . . .** Work exactly as for First Motif until 4th rnd has been completed. **5th rnd:** Make 1 corner scallop and 3 side scallops; now join the side of 2 motifs together as follows: In next corner loop on Second Motif make (3 sc, picot) twice and 3 sc; *ch 1, sl st in first picot made on any corner scallop on First Motif, ch 1, sl st in last sc made on Second Motif (joined picot made);* across Second Motif make 3 sc in same corner loop, sl st in same sc as next sl st was made; (in next loop make 2 sc, picot, 3 sc, joined picot going into center picot of next side scallop on First Motif, 3 sc, picot and 2 sc; sl st in same sc as next sl st was made) 3 times; in next corner loop make 3 sc, joined picot going into third picot made on next corner scallop of First Motif, 3 sc and (picot, 3 sc) twice—**side of 2 motifs now joined together;** to complete rnd make 3 side scallops, 1 corner scallop and 3 side scallops. Break off and fasten.

**Being sure to leave center picot of corner scallops free between joinings,** make 16 x 24 motifs for Single Size Spread or 20 x 24 motifs for Double Size Spread, joining motifs as Second Motif was joined to First Motif.

**BORDER . . . 1st rnd:** Attach thread to center picot of corner scallop preceding any of the 4 corners, sl st in center picot of scallop, \*\* (ch 9, sl st in center picot of next scallop) 7 times; \* ch 9,

sl st in center picot of next corner scallop, ch 5, sl st in center picot of next corner scallop, (ch 9, sl st in center picot of next scallop) 3 times. Repeat from \* across side to within last 3 side scallops. Sew strips neatly together. Block to measurements.

**EDGING . . . 1st rnd:** Attach thread and sc closely around, making 3 sc in each corner. Join to first sc. **2nd rnd:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around, making 3 sc in each corner. 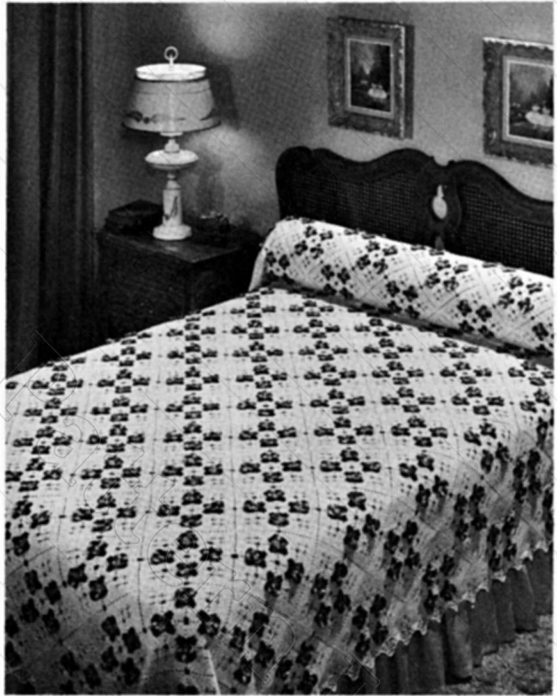

to make a pc st, make 5 dc in designated place, drop loop off hook, insert hook in first dc of 5-dc group and draw dropped loop through, ch 1 to fasten. Join to first sc (5 Yellow loops). Break off and fasten. **2nd rnd:** Attach Purple in joining, ch 1, (sc in next sc, ch 5) 4 times. Join as before (4 Purple loops). **3rd rnd:** Holding the Purple loops to back of work and out of the way, in each of the next 3 Yellow loops on first rnd make sc, 5 dc and sc (3 small petals made); in each of the next 2 Yellow loops make sc, 2 dc, 3 tr, 2 dc and sc (2 large petals made). Do not join. **4th rnd:** Across first small petal make sl st in first sc, ch 3, 2 dc in next 4 dc, 2 sc in next dc and sc in last sc; across next small petal make sl st in first sc, ch 3, 2 dc in next 5 dc, ch 3 and sl st in last sc; across next small petal make sc in first sc, 2 sc in next dc, 2 dc in next 4 dc, ch 3 and sl st in last sc; across each of the next 2 large petals make sc in first sc, 2 dc in next dc, 3 tr in next 5 sts, 2 dc in next dc and sc in last sc. Join to first sc. Break off and fasten. **5th rnd:** Attach Green to center of any Purple loop on 2nd rnd, ch 6, 3 dc in loop, in each of the next 3 loops make 4 dc, ch 3 and 3 dc; 3 dc in first loop. Join to 3rd ch of ch-6 (4 sps). Drop Green.

**NOTE:** On the next 2 rnds, always work over the strand of unused color to conceal and carry it across the section being made.

**6th rnd:** Leaving a 4-inch end, draw a White loop through loop on hook, ch 2, working over White end and Green strand, in next sp with White make 2 dc, ch 3 and 2 dc (shell made); \* dc in next dc changing to Green—to change colors with color in use, complete a dc to the point where 2 loops remain on hook, drop color; with new color complete the dc; with Green make (pc st in next dc, dc in next dc) twice; changing to White when making the 5th dc,

of pc st, make a pc st in next dc; White dc in next dc, White shell in next sp. Repeat from \* around, ending with pc st in last dc, changing to White as before. With White join to top of ch 2.

**7th rnd:** With White, ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, \* with White make shell in next shell sp, dc in next 3 dc and dc in top of next pc st changing to Green; with Green make pc st in next dc, dc in top of next pc st and changing to White as on 6th rnd, pc st in next dc; with White make dc in top of next pc st, dc in next 3 dc. Repeat from \* around, ending with a White dc in last pc st. Join to top of ch-3. Break off and fasten Green. **8th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in next 4 dc, \* shell in next shell sp, dc in next 6 dc, dc in top of next pc st, dc in next dc, dc in top of next pc st, dc in next 6 dc. Repeat from \* around, ending with dc in last dc. Join as before. Break off and fasten (19 dc on each side of Motif).

**PANSY BLOCK . . .** Leaving corner chains free and picking up back loops only, neatly sew the 19 dc on side of 4 Motifs together, having the large petals of pansies in outer corners. **NOTE:** If desired, for greater strength use a matching strand of Coats & Clark's O.N.T. Nylon Sewing Thread together with crochet thread when sewing Motifs together. Make 124 Blocks for Single Size or 143 Blocks for Double Size Spread.

**PLAIN BLOCK . . .** Starting at center with White, ch 6. Join to form ring. **1st rnd:** Ch 3, in ring make 4 dc and (ch 3, 5 dc) 3 times; ch 1, h dc in top of ch-3 to form last sp. **2nd and next 3 rnds:** Ch 3, dc in sp just formed and in top of ch-3 (same place as h dc was made); \* dc in each dc across to within next sp; shell in next sp. Repeat from \* around, ending with 2 dc in first sp used, ch 1, h dc in top of ch-3 to form last shell sp and complete first shell. **6th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in sp, in top of ch-3 and in next

7 dc; \* dc in next dc, ch 3, skip next dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, skip next dc, dc in next dc (lacet over 5 sts made); dc in next 8 dc, shell in next shell sp, dc in next 8 dc. Repeat from \* around, ending as on 2nd rnd. **7th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in sp and in top of ch-3; \* dc in each dc across to within next lacet; dc in first dc of lacet, ch 1, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, tr in first dc and in second dc of lacet, thread over and draw through all 3 loops on hook, ch 1, dc in second dc of lacet (inverted lacet over lacet made); dc in each dc across to within next shell sp, shell in next shell sp. Repeat from \* around, ending as before.

**8th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in sp, top of ch-3 and in next 7 dc; \* lacet over next 5 sts, dc in next ch-1 sp, in next st and in next ch-1 sp; lacet over next 5 sts; dc in next 8 dc, shell in next shell sp, dc in next 8 dc. Repeat from \* around, ending as before. **9th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in sp and top of ch-3; \* (dc in each dc across to within next lacet; inverted lacet over lacet) twice; dc in each dc across to within next shell sp, shell in next shell sp (corner). Repeat from \* around, ending as before. **10th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in sp and top of ch-3, \* dc in each st and sp across side to within center 5 dc; lacet over center 5 sts; dc in each sp and st across remainder of side to corner shell sp, shell in next corner shell sp. Repeat from \* around, ending as before. Break off and fasten (19 dc each side of center lacet on each side of Block). Make 123 Blocks for Single Size or 142 Blocks for Double Size Spread.

Having a Pansy Block at each corner, alternating the Blocks and leaving chains free, sew the back loops of each group of 19 dc together having 13 x 19 Blocks for Single Size, or 15 x 19 Blocks for Double Size Spread.

**EDGING . . . 1st rnd (right side):** Attach White to center of one of the 4 corner shell sps, 3 sc in corner shell sp, \* sc in next 19 dc, 3 sc in each of next 2 sps. Repeat from \* around, making 6 sc in each of next 3 corner shell sps and end with 3 sc in first corner shell sp used. Join. **2nd rnd:** Ch 7, dc in joining (starting V st made); \* ch 7, skip next 6 sc, sc in next 12 sc, ch 7, skip next 6 sc, in next sc make dc, ch 3 and dc (V st made). Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 3, tr in 3rd ch of ch-7 to form last loop. **3rd rnd:** Ch 1, sc in loop just formed, \*\* ch 5, in next corner V-st sp make (dc, ch 3) twice and dc—double V st made; \* ch 5, sc in next loop, ch 5, skip next sc, sc in next 10 sc, ch 5, sc in next loop, ch 5, V st in next V-st sp (V st over V st made). Repeat from \* across side to within next corner V-st sp. Repeat from \*\* around, ending with ch 2, dc in first sc to form last loop.

**4th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in loop, ch 3, sc in next loop, \*\* ch 5, V st in first double V-st sp, ch 4, V st in second double V-st sp, \* ch 5, sc in next loop, ch 3, sc in next loop, ch 5, skip next sc, sc in next 8 sc, ch 5, sc in next loop, ch 3, sc in next loop, ch 5, V st over V st. Repeat from \* across side to within next corner double V st. Repeat from \*\* around, ending as on 3rd rnd. **5th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in loop, ch 5, skip next ch-3, sc in next loop, \*\* ch 5, sc in first corner V st, ch 5, double V st in next ch-4 loop, ch 5, sc in second corner V st, \* ch 5, sc in next loop, ch 5, skip next ch-3, sc in next loop, ch 5, skip next sc, sc in next 3 sc, ch 3, sc in next 3 sc, ch 5, sc in next loop, ch 5, skip next ch-3, sc in next loop, ch 5, V st over V st. Repeat from \* across side to within first V st of corner. Repeat from \*\* around, ending with ch 5. Join to first sc. **6th rnd:** Ch 1, sc around making 4 sc in V-st sps, 5 sc in ch-5 loops and 3 sc in ch-3 loops. Join. Break off and fasten.

loop on First Motif, ch 4; on Second Motif, skip next 2 V-st sps, sc in first st of next V st) 5 times; ch 4, sl st in next loop on First Motif, ch 4; on Second Motif, skip next V-st sp, sc in next sp, ch 11, 3-d tr cluster in corner d tr; sl st in corner cluster on First Motif; starting at \* on 14th rnd of First Motif, complete Second Motif exactly as for First Motif (no more joinings).

Make 11 x 11 motifs for Small Cloth, or 11 x 15 motifs for Large Cloth, joining motifs as Second Motif was joined to First Motif (where corners meet, join corners to previous joinings).

**BORDER . . . 1st rnd:** Attach thread in ch-11 loop preceding any corner, \*\* holding back loops as for previous clusters, draw up a loop in ch-11 loop, make 2 d tr in corner cluster, thread over and draw through all loops (right cluster made); ch 10, 3-d tr cluster in same corner cluster, ch 10, holding back

loops as before, make 2 d tr in same corner cluster, then draw up a loop in next ch-11 loop, thread over and draw through all loops (left cluster made); \* ch 10, (sc in next ch-9 loop, ch 10) 7 times; make a right cluster going into next ch-11 loop and the joining between motifs, ch 10, make a left cluster going into same joining and next ch-11 loop. Repeat from \* across to within ch-11 loop preceding next corner. Repeat from \*\* around, ending with ch 5, d tr in first sc to form last loop. **2nd rnd:** Sc in loop just formed, ch 10, sc in next loop, \*\* ch 5, in corner cluster make d tr, ch 10 and d tr; ch 5, sc in next loop; \* ch 10, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* across to within next corner cluster. Repeat from \*\* around, forming last loop as before. **3rd rnd:** (Sc in loop, ch 10) 3 times; \*\* in corner loop make (tr, ch 10) twice; \* sc in next loop, ch 10. Repeat from \* across to within next corner loop. Repeat from \*\* around, ending with ch 10. Join break off and fasten.
