MATERIAL:

YARNS:—Corticelli Acetate Crochet Twist, Shade 497 Coral—8 Skeins.

NEEDLES:-YP22 Double End Crochet Hook, Size 5 -1 Only.

TRIMMINGS:--14 Buttons.

BACK— Ch 139. Patt: 1st row: Skip 3 ch, 3 DC in next st, * skip 2 ch, 1 SC in next ch, ch 2, skip 2 ch, 3 DC in next ch. Rep from * across row end skip 2 ch, 1 SC in next ch, ch 3 turn. 2nd row: 3 DC in SC, * skip 2 DC, 1 SC in next DC, ch 2, 3 DC in next SC. Rep from * across row end 1 SC in last DC, ch 3 turn. (These 2 rows form patt). Cont in patt until work measures 9 inches from beg. Shape armholes: Sl st over the 1st 8 sts beg of next 2 rows. Sl st over 3 sts beg of every row. 10 times. Work even until armholes measure 7 inches from 1st dec. Shape shoulder by sl st over 2 patts beg of next 6 rows. Fasten off.

FRONT – Ch 157. Work in patt to correspond with Back for 6 inches. Next row: work on the 1st 8½ patts, turn. Cont work in patt on these patts until work measures 9 inches from beg. Shape armhole to correspond with Back. Work even until armhole measures 7 inches from 1st dec. Shape shoulder to correspond with Back. Fasten off. Work other side to correspond join yarn to the 8½ patt from seam edge. (The rem patts in centre are for vest front).

VEST (2)– Ch 18, skip 1 ch, work 1 SC in each ch across row (17 SC). Rep this row until work measures 10 inches. Fasten off. Place vest in centre space of Front and crochet edges tog. Join shoulder seams. Work 2 rows of SC around neck and down front edges, making 6 loops on right side for button holes. Crochet side seams tog.

BANDS (2) -Ch 28, skip 1 ch, work 1 SC in each ch across row (27 SC). Rep this row until work measures 12½ inches. Fasten off. Join to lower edges of Blouse with a SC leaving bands open at seam. Work 2 rows of SC at side edges only making 4 locps on front edges only for buttonholes.

SLEEVES (2) – Ch 119. Work in patt until sleeve measures 4 inches. Shape armhole: sl st over the 1st 8 sts beg next 2 rows. Sl st over 3 sts beg of every row until 11 patts rem. * sl st over 6 sts beg next 2 rows. Work 1 inch even. Rep from * until 5 patts rem. Fasten off.

BANDS (2) -Ch. 15, skip 1 ch, 1 SC in each ch across rcw (14 SC). Rep this row until work measures 8 inches. Fasten off. Join to edge of sleeve. Set in sleeves with a SC. Press lightly. Sew on buttons.

MATERIAL:

YARNS:-Corticelli Acetate Crochet Twist, No. 101 White-3 Skeins.

NEEDLES:—YP22 Double End Crochet Hook, Size 5—I Only.

TRIMMINGS:—1 Yard Beldings 1" Satin Ribbon.

2 Yards Beldings 1/4" Satin Ribbon.

JACKET—Ch 97, turn. 1 DC in 2nd ch from hook, 1 DC in each of the next 16 ch, ch 2, 1 DC in each of the next 17 ch, ch 2, 1 DC in next 30 ch, ch 2, 1 DC in next 17 ch, ch 2, 1 DC in next 16 ch, ch 2, turn. 2nd row: 1 DC in each of next 16 DC, 1 DC in next ch, ch 2, 1 DC in next ch, 1 DC in next 17 DC, 1 DC in next ch, ch 2, 1 DC in next ch, 1 DC in next 16 DC. Cont as last 2 rows having 1 more st on each front, 2 on each sleeve, 2 on back, until 11 rows are worked (184 DC). Start patt. 1st row: *3 DC, skip 2, 1 SC in next st, rep from * across front. Ch 11, join to 1st DC on back (armhole). Rep from * to * across back. Ch 11, join to 1st DC on other front, rep from * to * across front end 3 DC, ch 3 turn. 2nd row: Skip 2 DC, 1 SC in next DC, * ch 2, 1 SC in next DC, ch 2, skip 1 DC, SC in next DC, rep from * across row. 3rd row: Ch 2, 1 SC in centre of ch on previous row, * ch 2, 3 DC in ch 2 of previous row, ch 2, 1 SC in centre of ch 2 of previous row, rep from * across row. Rep last 2 rows 10 times, ch 2 turn. Next row: * 3 DC in ch 2 of previous row, 1 SC in next SC, rep from * across row. Fasten off.

SLEEVES (2)—Join yarn to yoke and work in patt around armhole until sleeve measures 7½ inches from top. Work beading * ch 2, skip 2 sts, 1 DC in next st, rep from * around row. **Next row**: Work * 3 DC in ch 2 of previous row, 1 SC in DC, rep from * around row. Fasten off.

BEADING AROUND NECK—Join yarn at neck edge, * ch 2, skip 2 sts, 1 DC in next st, rep from * around neck. Fasten off. Work one row of SC down each front opening.

TO MAKE UP—Press lightly. Thread ribbon through eyelets around neck and sleeves. then through first row of patt.

more rows of SC. Work in patt to correspond with Jacket for 2½ inches. Fasten off. Instep: Join yarn to the 15 SC from edge, work in SC on next 10 sts for 1 inch. Fasten off. Foot: join back seam. Fasten yarn at seam edge, work in SC across 1st 15 SC along instep, work 3 SC in 1st SC (front of instep), 1 SC in next 8 SC, 3 SC in next SC along other side of instep, across last 15 SC. Work 12 rows of SC. Fasten off. Sole: Ch. 19. 1st round: 1 SC in 2nd ch from hook, 1 SC in each ch to last ch, 3 SC in last ch. Working along opposite side of ch work 1 SC in each st end 3 SC in last ch, join with a sl st. 2nd round: Ch 3, 1 DC in each SC and 2 DC in each 3 SC. 3rd and 4th rounds: Ch 3, 1 DC in each DC, 2 DC in each end DC. Fasten off. Join sole to bootees with 1 row of SC. Thread ribbon through 1st row of patt.

BONNET—Ch 3 join. Work 11 DC in ring, join with a sl st. **2nd round**: 2 DC in each DC, join all rows with a sl st. **3rd and 4th rounds**: Inc 1 st in every other st. **5th round**: Inc 1 st every 3rd st. **6th and 7th rounds**: Work 1 DC in each st.

YARNS: Corticelli Acetate Crochet Twist, Shade 463 Straw-8 Skeins.

NEEDLES:-YP22 Double End Crochet Hook, Size 5-1 Only.

TRIMMINGS:—8 Buttons.

BACK—Ch. 142. Patt: 1st row: 1 DC in 3rd ch from hook, 1 DC in each of next 2 sts, * 1 TRC in next ch, work through only 2 loops on hook, thread over hook once, skip 2 ch, insert in next ch work through 2 loops 4 times, ch 2, 1 DC in centre of TRC (this forms a cross st), 1 DC in each of next 4 ch, rep from * across row, ch 2. 2nd row: 1 DC in 1st st, 1 cross st on 1st 4 DC, * 4 DC on cross st of previous row, 1 cross st on 4 DC of previous row, rep from * across row end with a cross st on 4 DC of previous row, ch 2. 3rd row: 4 DC on cross st of previous row, * 1 cross st on 4 DC of previous row, 4 DC on cross st of previous row, rep from * across row, ch. 2. Cont last 2 rows until work measures 9 inches from beg. Shape armholes: Sl st over the 1st 8 sts beg of next 2 rows. Sl st over 4 sts beg of every row 6 times. Work even until armholes measure 6 inches from 1st dec. Next row: Work over 4½ patts, turn. Cont working over these patts until armhole measures 7 inches from 1st dec. Fasten off. Join yarn to other side of 4½ patts from armhole and work to correspond.

FRONT—Ch 150. Work in patt same as back up to armholes and shape armholes in same manner. Work even until armhole measures 5 inches from 1st dec. Cont as for back (make neck 1 inch lower in front).

SLEEVES (2)—Ch. 134. Work in patt until work measures 4 inches. Shape armholes: sl st over 1st 8 sts beg of next 2 rows. Sl st over 4 sts beg of every row until 6½ patts rem. Fasten off.

WAIST BAND (2)—Ch 28, turn, 1 SC in 2nd ch from hook, 1 SC in each ch (27 SC). Rep this row until band measures 13 inches. Fasten off. Join side seam with a SC. Join bands to lower edge of blouse with a SC leaving side open. Work 2 rows of SC around side opening making 4 loops on front edges for buttonholes. Join shoulder with a SC. Work 6 rows of SC around neck opening.

SLEEVE BANDS (2)—Ch 15, turn. 1 SC in 2nd ch from hook, 1 SC in each ch (14 SC). Rep this row until band measures 8 inches. Fasten off. Join bands to sleeves with a SC. Set in sleeves. Press lightly. Sew buttons to each side.

8th round: Work to within 8 sts of row, ch 1, turn. Work back and forth in DC in each st for 8 rows. Work 4 rows of patt then 6 rows of DC. Work 6 rows of SC. Fasten off. Join yarn at lower edge. Work 4 rows of SC. Frill: join yarn to the 2nd row of DC at lower edge. Work 1 SC in each st across row, ch 1, turn. Next row: Inc 1 st in every 4th st on row, ch 1, turn. Next row: Work in DC inc 1 st in every 3rd st across row, ch 2. Next row: 1 DC in each st, ch 1, turn. Next row: 1 SC in each st with a picot every 5th st. Fasten off. Finish each side of bonnet with ribbon bows.

YARNS:—Corticelli Acetate Crochet Twist, Shade 101 White—8 Skeins.

NEEDLES:—YP22 Double End Crochet Hook, Size 5—1 Only.

TRIMMINGS:-14 Buttons.

PATT.—1st row: Skip 1 ch, 4 DC in next 4 ch, * ch 2, skip 2 ch, 1 DC in next ch, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next ch, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next 4 ch, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next 4 ch. Rep from * across row. 2nd row: * 1 DC in each of the 4 DC, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next st, 2 DC in next 2 ch, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 1, 1 DC in next st, 2 DC in next 2 ch, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 1, 1 DC in next st, 2 DC in next 2 ch, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 2. Rep from * end 4 DC. 3rd row: As 1st row. 4th row: * 1 DC in each of the 4 DC, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC in next st, ch 2, skip 2. Rep from * end 4 DC. 5th, 6th and 7th rows: As 4th row. (7 rows to patt).

BACK—Ch 125. Skip 1 ch, work 4 rows of HDC (124 HDC). **Next row:** Start patt. Work 4 rows of patt then dec 1 st beg and end of every 4th row, 4 times. Work 6 rows even. Inc 1 st beg and end of every 4th row, 8 times. Work even until work measures 12½ inches from beg. Shape armholes: SI st over the 1st 8 DC beg of next 2 rows. Dec. 2 sts beg of next 10 rows (same manner). Work even until armholes measure 7 inches from 1st dec. Shape shoulder by sI st over 8 sts beg of next 8 rows. Fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT—Ch 75. Skip 1 ch, work 4 rows of HDC (74 HDC). Start patt. 1st row: Work 4 DC, ch 2 (buttonhole), skip 2, 2 DC in next 2 sts, * ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC, ch 2, skip 2, 2 DC. Rep from * once. Ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC, ch 2, skip 2, 1 DC, ch 2, skip 2, 4 DC, ch 2, skip 2, 4 DC. Cont working in patt as for back and keep the 1st 8 sts at front opening in DC up to neck and make buttonholes every 5th row. (14 buttonholes). Dec and inc at seam edge to correspond with back. When work measures 12½ inches from beg shape armhole by sl st over the 1st 8 sts at seam edge then dec 2 sts same edge, 6 times. Work even until armhole measures 5 inches from beg. Shape neck: sl st over the 1st 8 sts at front opening. Sl st over 2 sts same edge until armhole measures 7 inches from 1st dec. Shape shoulder to correspond with back. Fasten off.

LEFT FRONT—Work to correspond with Right Front omitting buttonholes.

SLEEVES (2)—Ch 53. Skip 1 ch, work 6 rows of HDC (52 HDC). Work in patt as for back. Work 7 rows even. Inc 1 st beg and end of next and every 3rd row, 8 times. (Work all inc sts in patt). Inc 1 st beg and end of every row until sleeve measures 14 inches from beg. Work even until sleeve measures 17 inches from beg. Shape armhole: sl st over 1st 8 sts of next 2 rows. Sl st over 2 sts beg of every row until 28 sts rem. Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP—Crochet all seams tog. Set in sleeves. Work 3 rows of HDC around neck. Press lightly. Sew on buttons.
